Step-by-step process for preparation and submission of incident reports



Documenting abuses

- Trained individuals inside Vietnam document abuses and verify relevant information, and carefully note what information can be used publically and what is confidential.
- Experienced and knowledgeable coach, based inside or outside of Vietnam:
 - reviews the information provided

- verifies it with independent sources
- > obtains additional information if necessary

Compiling report

- Experienced coach compiles the report in accordance with the standard format
- Members of a Research Committee based outside of Vietnam:
 - review the draft report for consistency
 - solicit additional information if needed
 - > make editorial modifications as appropriate
 - translate the final draft into English



Submission of report

- A designated organization based outside of Vietnam submits the report to the UN Special Rapporteur and conducts follow-ups
- The designated organization also looks into other possible advocacy channels including foreign governments
- Reports that do not contain sensitive personal information are posted at <u>http://dvov.org/religious-freedom/</u>
