Bui Thi Bich Tuyen is Bui Van Trung's daughter. She was not arrested along with her brother and father in June 2017, but her movement has been restricted within her locality. She was tried on February 9 in An Giang province under Article 245, "Causing public disorder", and was sentenced to 3 years.

Vu Van Hung, former teacher and pro-democracy activist is now formally charged with "causing public disorder" under Article 318 of the new 2015 Criminal Code. Member of the Brotherhood for Democracy, he was kidnapped from a lunch meeting on January 4, 2018 and awaits trial in incommunicado detention. Former POC, he was arrested on Sept. 8, 2008 and tried on Oct. 2009 under Article 88. He was released in 2011 after serving his full 3 years' sentence.

Abducted on January 4, 2018, Vu Van Hung is now formally charged with "causing public disorder" under Article 318 of the new 2015 Criminal Code.

Nguyen Nam Phong was the driver of Catholic priest Nguyen Dinh Thuc, from the Song Ngoc parish, and activist Hoang Duc Binh when Hoang Duc Binh was arrested on May 15, 2017 in Nghe An province. Binh was escorting priest Nguyen Dinh Thuc from the Song Ngoc parish in Dien Chau district to Vinh city. The police stopped their car in Dien Chau district's center and violently removed Binh from the car. When the police ordered the driver, Phong, to open the car to let them to take Binh out, Phong refused. Nguyen Nam Phong was arrested 6 month after the incident, on November 28, 2017, and charged with "resisting persons in the performance of their official duties" under Article 330 of the 2015 Criminal Code. He has faced trial on February 6, 2018, together with Hoang Duc Binh, and sentenced to 2 years term.

Hoa Hao Buddhist and friend of Bui Quang Trung, Hanh was arrested on November 13, 2017 and charged under Article 245 of the 1999 Penal code, "Causing public disorder". She was sentenced on February 9, 2018, along with 5 other Hoa Hao Buddhists, to 3 years in prison.

On October 5 2017, authorities in Vietnam's northern province of Hoa Binh arrested former teacher Dao Quang Thuc and accused him of carrying out activities aimed at overthrowing the people's administration, under Article 79 of the Penal Code. Thuc retired recently from his day job as a teacher. He has participated in a number of peaceful activities which protested China's activities in the East Sea (South China Sea), as well as activities connected to environmental protection and highlighted corruption. He was outspoken in his views on social media, including Facebook.

Nguyen Van Tuc, a former prisoner of conscience and a member of the Brotherhood for Democracy, was arrested under Article 79 on September 1, 2017. He had previously served four years in prison under Article 88 for "propaganda against the state," from 2008 to 2012. He is at least the seventh member of the Brotherhood for Democracy, a group co-founded by lawyer and political prisoner Nguyen Van Dai, to be arrested this year. They are facing life imprisonment and even death sentences if are convicted.

As a jurist, Nguyen Bac Truyen provided pro-bono legal assistance to families of political prisoners, victims of land grabs and persecuted religious communities in Southern Vietnam. Early in the morning of July 30 2017, he was abducted by police while waiting for his wife (Bui Thi Kim Phuong) outside the Church of the Redemptorists in Ho Chi Minh City.

Pham Van Troi is a human rights defender and a former President of the Brotherhood for Democracy. Since his release in 2012, he has continued to work promoting human rights and multi-party democracy. On July 30, 2017, the Vietnamese authorities simultaneously arrested four human rights defenders, all current or former members of the Brotherhood for Democracy and former prisoners of conscience, at their homes in Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City and Thanh Hoa: Nguyen Trung Ton, Nguyen Bac Truyen, Pham Van Troi and Truong Minh Duc.

I do not know where they take him. " According to Tuoi Tre Newspaper, Luong "regularly engages in activities aiming at overthrowing the people's administration and complicates the local security and order".



In April 2015, Nguyen Viet Dung established the Republican Party, which is not recognized by the Vietnamese state, and the Loyalist Association of the ARVN. He regularly participated in protests against China's influence over Vietnam and its territorial claims in the South China Sea, and expressed views critical of the Vietnamese government.

Dung was arrested in April 2015 under Article 245 for "disturbing public order" after taking part in a rally calling for the protection of trees in the capital Hanoi and sentenced that December to a 15-month prison term. His sentence was later commuted by an appeal court to 12 months and he was released in April 2016.

On September 27 2017, Nguyen Viet Dung was kidnapped by plainclothes agents at noon while taking lunch in his native province of Nghe An, according to local activists. A group of around ten kidnappers came with three motorbikes and a seven-seat car. The kidnappers acted so fast that people nearby could not intervene to help Dung. They were in such in a hurry, that they left one of their motorbikes and some documents behind. No arrest warrant was presented before Dung was hauled away. According to his father, the Vietnamese police had "only issued an announcement" [acknowledging the arrest] due to strong public pressure.

Phuc is a 23 year old activist based in Ho Chi Minh City. He publicly calls for multi-party democracy and human rights as well as environmental protection. In late May last year, when then US President Barack Obama visited Ho Chi Minh City, he was invited to meet him but was detained by local security shortly prior to the meeting. He was arrested on June 26 2017, and charged on July 3 2017 with "conducting propaganda against the state" under Article 88 of the 1999 Penal Code because he assisted Nguyen Van Dien and Vu Quang Thuan on posting some of their videos online. He was sentenced on January 31, 2018 to 6 years in prison.

Binh is a member of the independent Viet Labour Movement and a well-known blogger who has covered news on the Formosa environmental disaster in the central coastal provinces of Vietnam. On Monday May 15 2017, Binh was travelling in a car with Catholic priest Nguyen Dinh Thuc from the Song Ngoc parish in Dien Chau district to Vinh city. Their car was stopped by police in Dien Chau district and police violently removed Binh from the car. He was initially detained in Nghe An temporary detention centre but his family learned he had been moved to B14 Detention Centre in Hanoi. He was supposed to face trial on January 25, 2018 for "resisting persons in the performance of their official duties" under Article 330 and "Abusing democratic freedoms to infringe upon the interests of the State" under Article 331 of the new 2015 Criminal Code, but the trial was postponed to Feb. 6, 2018. He received a 14 years sentence: 7 years for "abusing democratic freedoms to infringe state interests" and 7 years for "opposing officials on duty".

Khanh is accused by police of managing two blogs, "Bao Tham nhung" (Corruption Newspaper) and "Tuan bao Viet Nam" (Vietnam Weekly) and three Facebook accounts namely "Bao Tham nhung", "Tuan bao Viet Nam" and "Dan chu TV" (Democracy TV) as well as two YouTube channels namely "Viet Bao TV" and "Vietnam Online." Vietnam's authorities said Khanh used these social networks to propagandize anti-state information. Police also said that Khanh had contacted people considered by the authorities as reactionary individuals, including former political prisoner Nguyen Van Hai (aka Dieu Cay), who is living in exile in the US after being years in prison in Vietnam. Khanh is also accused of helping to managed some websites of the Vietnam Reform Party (Viet Tan), a US based pro-democracy group considered as a terrorist organization by Vietnam's government. Khanh was tried on October 25, 2017 with "conducting anti-state propaganda" under Article 88.





Article 79 of the Penal Code and sentenced to between 4 and 13 years in prison. His most recent arrest took place while he was on his way home from a fishing trip in Hoang Mai commune, Nghe An Province on January 19 2017. Local authorities accused him of failing to obey the regulations of his three year house arrest.

He was tried and sentenced to 5 years' prison on September 18, 2017. He has appealed the decision of Hoang Mai town's People's Court but his appeal was denied.

Tran Thi Nga, also known as "Thuy Nga", was arrested in January 21 2017 for sharing articles and videos online highlighting ongoing rights abuses tied to environmental crises and political corruption. For a decade, Tran Thi Nga has carried out her fight against injustice despite government intimidation and assault. In May 2014, a targeted attack by five men on the street in Hanoi left her with a broken arm and leg. In August 2015, she was dragged from a bus and beaten by plainclothes police after visiting a recently released political prisoner. Yet she was obstinate, continuing to speak out against the assaults and broader state violence.

Arrested on January 21 2017, Tran Thi Nga was sentenced to 9 years in prison followed by 5 years' house arrest for spreading "anti-State propaganda", under Article 88 of the Penal Code. Her appeal was rejected on December 22, 2017.

Hoa is a young activist from Ky Anh, Ha Tinh, one of the areas that were the most affected by the environmental disaster caused by Formosa dumping industrial waste to the sea in 2016. On June 23 2017, authorities stated that Nguyen Van Hoa had declined to have his own lawyer even though his family had hired to defend human rights lawyer Ha Huy Son to represent him.

He was arrested on January 11 2017 but his family only received the temporary detention notice from the authorities on January 23. According to the notice, Hoa was arrested

under Article 258 of the Penal Code for "abusing democratic freedoms to infringe upon the interests of the State". On November 27, 2017 he was convicted under Article 88 and sentenced to 7 years in prison and 3 years' probation on release.



has written about politically sensitive issues such as police brutality, corruption, and has openly criticized controversial government's policies such as the bauxite mining in the Central Highlands (for which she was arrested for 10 days in 2009), and, more recently, the government handling of the massive fish deaths in Central Vietnam. She was awarded for her advocacy work "the 2015 Civil Rights Defender of the Year" by Civil Rights Defenders and was granted the International Women of Courage Award earlier this year by the U.S. State Department, though she was unable to accept it in person. Her mother was also barred from visiting her in detention. Arrested on October 10, 2016, she was officially charged under Article 88 of the Penal Code after two months in pre-trial detention, and was sentenced to 10 years in prison in June 2017. Her appeal trial was rejected on Nov. 30, 2017, by the court of Nha Trang; her 10 years' sentence is upheld. She was recently transferred from Khanh Hoa detention centre to Thanh Hoa Prison n°5, between January and February 2018.





A lawyer, Mr. Nguyen is a well-known peaceful campaigner for a multi-party democracy and the protection of human rights in Vietnam. Nguyen Van Dai has repeatedly been subjected to unwarranted persecution for undertaking his legitimate work. In 2007, he was convicted under Article 88 of the Penal Code and sentenced to 4 years in prison. At the time, he had been holding seminars to teach students about the fundamentals of a free society and the rule of law.

Between his release in 2011 and his most recent arrest, he had been subjected to countless incidents of harassment and surveillance by police officers. At the time of his arrest, he was still recovering from injuries sustained from a vicious assault by masked assailants on December 6 2015, after he had attended a meeting to mark International Human Rights Day. He was badly beaten, robbed and thrown on the street.

Arrested again on December 16, 2015 and charged with "conducting anti-state propaganda" under Article 88 of the Penal Code, and more recently with subversion under Article 79 of the Penal Code. He has been in pre-trial detention for 11 months.

Y Kur Bdap is a Protestant minister whose independent church did not belong to any government-sponsored and government-sanctioned religious organisations; he was not licensed to operate. The local police in Ea Bhok Commune of Cu Kuin District often harassed and manhandled him. Undeterred, he continued to practice his faith and preached God's words to his ethnic Montagnard minority people. The local government and police attempted every way possible to isolate him from his community to prevent him doing his ministry work. He attempted to flee Vietnam when he learned his arrest was imminent.

He was arrested on April 24, 2004 and subsequently put on trial. He was convicted on two counts: i) illegal border crossing and sentenced him to 12 years; and ii) inciting divisiveness among different ethnicities, he was sentenced to 5 years. His sentence amount to a total of 17 years.
