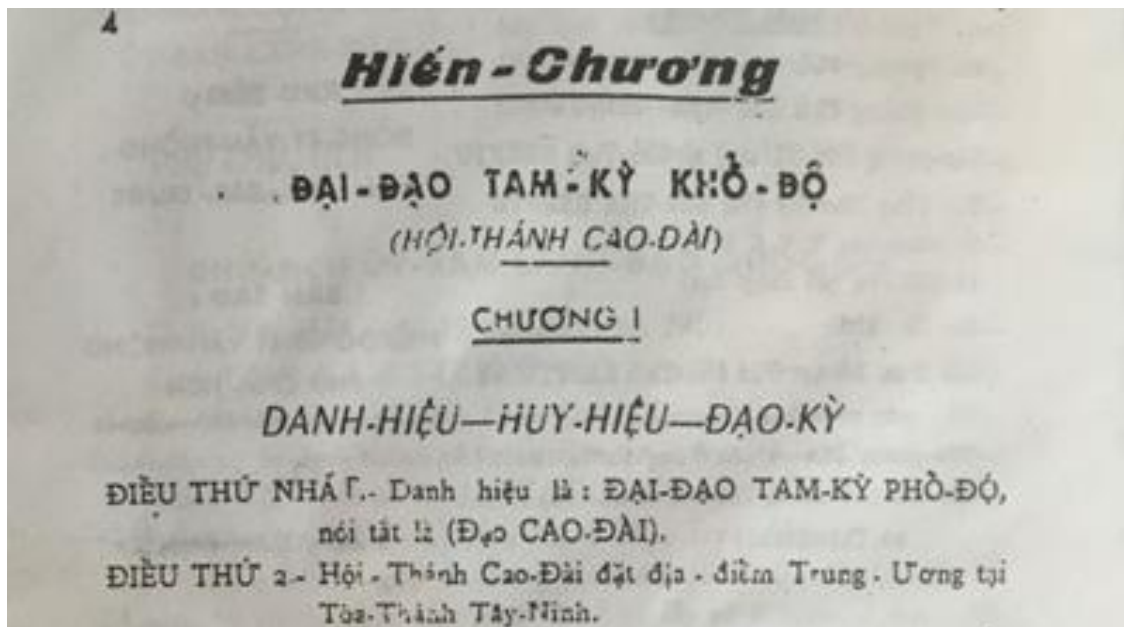


The 1997 Sect: Impersonation through “identity morphing”

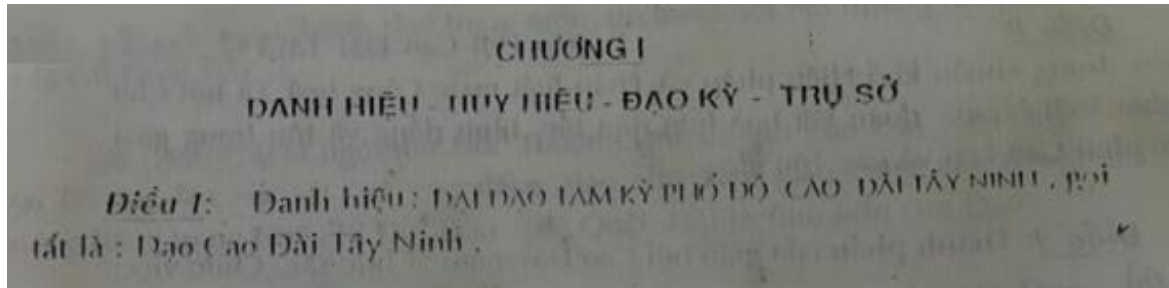
The official name of the Cao Dai Religion -- “Dai Dao Tam Ky Pho Do” -- as indicated in its 1965 Constitution:



By convention, its duration of existence in parentheses and the seat of its Sacerdotal Council are added as subtitles to the Cao Dai Religion’s official letterhead:



The 1997 Sect's official name as approved by the Communist Government in 1997: "Dai Dao Tam Ky Pho Do Cao Dai Tay Ninh"



In 2007, with Government's approval, the 1997 Sect changed its name to: "Dai Dao Tam Ky Pho Do (Cao Dai Toa Thanh Tay Ninh)". By adding "Toa Thanh" and putting in parentheses "Cao Dai Toa Thanh Tay Ninh," the 1997 Sect implied that its name is "Dai Dao Tam Ky Pho Do," which is the official name of the Cao Dai Religion, and that "Cao Dai Toa Thanh Tay Ninh" is an alias indicating the seat of its Holy See.
